Stormwater NSW will hold its Annual General Meeting for all members on Thursday, 7th September, 2017 from 8.30 am to 9.00 am at the Newcastle Convention and Exhibition Centre, King Street and Union Street, Newcastle West.

All members of Stormwater NSW are invited to nominate for a position on the management committee for 2017/2018. Stormwater NSW are seeking committee members that are eager and enthusiastic to advance the stormwater industry and who want to play an active role in setting the direction of the Association and its activities. Participation on the committee is also of personal benefit, providing professional development and networking opportunities.

Each nominee should indicate if they wish to stand as one of 4 Office Bearers (President, Vice President, Secretary or Treasurer) or as a General Committee Member. The office bearers will be elected at the first committee meeting following the AGM. The Association cannot accept more than three persons in any one industry category to serve on the committee and if there are more than three nominations within a category, then a ballot will be held at the AGM. This is to ensure there is a range of interests and disciplines representing the Association.

Nominees should take note of the following:

- i. Committee meetings are generally held on the second Thursday of every **second** month between 9.00am and 11.00am.
- ii. Committee members are expected to play an active role in Association activities and will be required to undertake a specific role or task, including participation on a sub-committee. This will require effort outside of the monthly committee meetings.
- iii. Should there be more than one nomination for an executive position on the committee (i.e. President, Vice President or Treasurer) the nominees for the position will be required to submit a brief bio (maximum 100 words) to the committee prior to the AGM.

Nominations for the Stormwater NSW committee for 2017/2018 need to be completed and returned prior to the AGM to the Association Secretariat via email to siansw@stormwater.asn.au by no later than **Thursday, 31st August, 2017**.
